36th Annual National Training Seminar

JAG's 36th Annual National Training Seminar was held July 7-12 at Disney's Coronado Springs Resort in Orlando, Florida. JAG staff from across the United States and Virgin Islands came to the seminar for the JAG National Network professional development experience. Region One sent six staff affiliated with JAG to attend the training.

The theme this year was "The JAG Advantage...There's More to the Story." The week-long training seminar included professional development activities and best practices training workshops that went over a variety of topics such as project based learning, trauma informed care strategies, and employer engagement.
